Landscaping Volunteers

Help Us Grow Stronger Together! Gather your coworkers (up to 29 of them!) and help transform our outdoor spaces with fresh mulch and newly planted flowers. Your team can make a lasting impact while creating a beautiful and welcoming environment for the people we serve.

Groups of up to 30 volunteers can visit one of our main campuses—Koch, Bren, Karlins, or Asplin—to assist with mulching, weeding, planting, and other landscaping tasks. If you prefer, your group can also divide up and tackle similar projects at several of our group homes.

Cooking for a Cause!

Our Most Popular Group Volunteer Opportunity! Gather a small group of family, friends, or coworkers and use one of our on-site kitchens to prepare meals for the residents of our 20 group homes. It's a fun and meaningful way to give back while bonding as a team!

- Groups of **2-10 volunteers** can visit one of our two sites in Minnetonka (**Koch & Bren**) to cook family-style meals. Each meal serves 8, and typically, groups will prepare **6-20 pans** of food during the event.
- No prior cooking skills are necessary! The recipes are simple and require basic tasks like chopping, cutting, and browning.
- **All kitchen tools, utensils, and appliances are provided by Opportunity Partners.** Once the meals are prepared, volunteers can either store them in our on-site freezer or personally deliver them to the homes.

*Cooking activities may incur costs for supplies and ingredients.

Classroom Connections Volunteer

Join Our Enrichment Classes Volunteer Team! Support our staff and coaches during Enrichment Classes at Koch by helping set up and break down the classroom, assisting students, and working alongside support coaches to create enriching opportunities for the people we serve.

Volunteers can choose to help out one day a week (Monday-Friday) during either the 8:00-10:30 AM or 11:00 AM-1:00 PM shifts—or both!

- Our Enrichment Classes cover a wide variety of activities, from traditional lessons to art projects, music, board games, and independent work. No teaching experience is necessary—just bring your enthusiasm and a willingness to learn and connect with the people we serve, and we'll find a place for you!
- If you're passionate about a particular topic or hobby, you can even host or teach a class on a subject of your choice! We're always looking to expand our Enrichment Program, and your unique skills and interests could be a great addition.

We ask for a minimum commitment of 3 months to ensure a consistent and stable learning environment for our persons served.
